TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Society Lottery Scheme is registered with National Lotteries Commission (Reg No. 00476/01).

Below are the official rules of the competition: These rules (together with any official competition communications) will govern and apply to the competition. Please take a moment to review these rules:

PARTICIPATION

1. By your participation, you agree that you understand that to participate in the **BEST OF OUDTSHOORN LOTTERY**, Oudtshoorn Sport Initiative (OSI) NPO 310-511 and WEBTICKETS must collect and use personal information about participants. This competition is conducted under the terms of applicable privacy statements. Consent is given to OSI to be added to future mailing lists or fundraising promotions.
2. The competition runs from 01 January 2025 – 28th April 2025. No late entries will be accepted.
3. To enter the competition participants need to purchase through the online ticket link on Webtickets – each ticket purchased per category equals an entry into the draw.
4. Lottery tickets cost R250 each. A maximum of 4000 tickets will be made available. A person may enter as many times as they like.
5. You must be at least 18 years old to buy a lottery ticket.
6. The winner of **BEST OF OUDTSHOORN LOTTERY** will be randomly chosen via a certified method of selection on 30th April 2025. The winner will be informed telephonically, after which an announcement on the name of the winner will be published on Oudtshoorn Sport Initiative's Facebook page and website: www.oudtshoornsport.co.za
7. Only entries reflected on the Webtickets online ticketing link will be treated as the validation source and will be the only evidence of successful entries.
8. Closing Date: Entries must be received no later than midnight on the 28th of April 2025.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PRIZES:

9. The Best of Oudtshoorn Lottery prize consists of a weeklong holiday in Oudtshoorn for a family of four people between 28th June 2025- 05 July 2025 (7 nights). Accommodation, meals and tourist experiences are included in the prize. The total value of the prize is estimated to be at least R70 000.00
